Rules & Conditions



Entry is free. An Entrant may enter as many times as they wish. All persons under 18yrs of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.



A Registration Form for each entry is to be fully completed and submitted to the Lakes Entrance Bowls Club (the Club) before 2.30pm on Sunday 9th April. Registrations may be made in person at the Club, via email at office@lakesbowls.com.au or at the Club's website at www.lakesbowls.com.au



Entrants accept that their Entry is a donation to the Club.



All Entries are to be completely home-made and baked by the Entrant.

NB. 13 and under Entrants may have adult assistance in the use of kitchen equipment & oven, but must weigh, measure, mix and decorate their Entry unassisted.



Entries are to comprise of either: a full sized cake, gateau, pudding, etc, or a plate of biscuits, muffins, slices, etc. (min 7 pieces). A 'tasting plate' for full sized Entries is encouraged but not mandatory, to avoid damage to the Auction item. All entries are to be sweet (no savoury items accepted)



For specific dietary awareness, all Entries must be accompanied with a full list of ingredients, written clearly on the form provided during Registration. This list will be supplied to the winning bidder when the item is auctioned.



All Entries must be submitted on a stable plate, cake board, tray etc. that will not be returned to the Entrant. Entries will be auctioned as presented. If practicable, Entries are to be covered with Glad- Wrap etc. during the display period.



Entries will be accepted by the Club, for display, from 12 noon on Sunday 9th April.



The Bake-Off and Auction will be held in the Members' Lounge area.

Entries cannot be refrigerated during this time, so consideration must be given by Entrants as to the keeping and presentation qualities of the baked goods.



Entries will be displayed in order of acceptance, and will be open for public viewing prior to judging. The 13yrs and Under Entries will be displayed on a separate table.



The Judging Panel will not be present during the acceptance of Entries and display set-up, and will not know the identity of Entries/Entrants. Any Entrant making themselves and their Entry known to a judge, will be disqualified from the Great Bake-Off Competition and the Entry will be retained for Auction.



Judges will assess each Entry on Taste, Appearance and Originality and award a 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place. In addition, a Winner will be selected from the 13yrs and Under Section.

Prizes are as follows:

- 1st Prize - \$500 Bulmers Gift Voucher
- 2nd Prize - \$200 Baking Pack
- 3rd Prize - \$100 Baking Pack
- 13yrs or Under Section - \$50 Baking Pack



All Entries will be auctioned following the Bake-Off Competition. All proceeds will be donated to the Royal Children's Hospital Good Friday Appeal.



If an Entrant wishes to keep their Entry, they must be the highest bidder at the time of Auction.



Throughout the Great Bake-Off Competition and Auction, the Club reserves the right to amend the Rules & Conditions if deemed necessary. In the case of any disagreement or query, the Club's decision is final.
